2. Individuals or couples who write or raise at least \$100,000 between January 1, 2007 and June 30, 2008.
3. Individuals or couples who write at least \$57,000 between January 1, 2007 and June 30, 2008. (Early contributions are encouraged and noted.)
4. Individuals or couples who write \$28,500 or more in 2007 or in 2008 before June 30, 2008. (Early contributions are encouraged and noted.)
