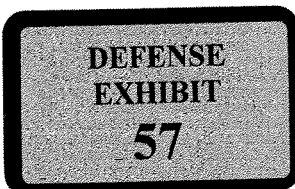
I also worked on this issue with David and Fred Benjamin. Jill Clark, of our

David asked me to send you the information below and the attached document. The attachment was submitted to Louanner on June 11. There are numerous considerations for the Governor in naming the new 9-member board and there is significant interest in the positions. We worked closely over the past 6 months with Louanner, Deanne, Dr. Whitaker, Speaker Madigan, Rep. Cross, Sen. Jones, Sen. Obama, Sen. Garrett (sponsor of SB 1332) and others to provide for an extension of Certificate of Need (CON) and a new Illinois Health Facilities Planning Board.
